WHAT TO BRING TO CLASS

- Unless it is a lecture or handwork class, bring your sewing machine and accessories. If you do not have one to bring, we have classroom machines that you may borrow.
- Basic Supplies – scissors, pins, tape measure, seam ripper, fabric markers, rotary cutter and ruler (quilting classes), extra bobbins.
- Supply List with all necessary items for your class project. There is a **10% discount** on all your purchases when you take a class! Download your supply list from the website.
- Bring a lunch to any all day classes or visit one of the restaurants nearby.
- Please do not bring babies or children to classes, and be courteous with your cell phone.

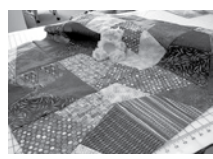
