

Hovea Quilted Jacket Supply List

- Megan Nielsen Hovea Jacket Pattern (Pick up in store, on hold for you).
- Sufficient fabric and batting to make jacket based on view and size on pattern envelope plus $\frac{1}{2}$ yard extra. The jacket is versatile and will work with a variety of fabrics, including quilting cottons, linen, twill, denim (not too heavy), canvas, etc. – no knits. Choose batting based on weight and drape you prefer, including but not limited to cotton, polyester, and wool. I made several samples using my chosen fabric to test quilting options, drape, etc.
- Matching thread – cotton thread preferred.
- Quilting ruler and rotary cutter (if you don't have one, don't worry. There will be rulers and rotary cutters available.
- Sewing shears
- Pins
- Machine needles – I recommend Microtex 90/14. Universal needles are also fine.
- Wash Away Wonder tape
- Seam ripper and other general sewing supplies
- We will be using the Accuquilt to cut bias binding in class but will also review manual cutting methods.
